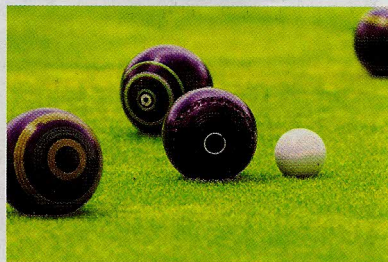


TRURO CITY BOWLING CLUB
